1. The Parent acknowledges that the Child will be participating in activities that subject the Child to risk, and the Parent on behalf of the Child, hereby releases and indemnifies the Club, its officers, employees and volunteers from and against any claims and/or liability that arise as a result of the Child’s participation in the Wee wanderers, or Club activities, with the exception of claims that arise as a result of the negligence and/or recklessness of the Club.
2. The Parent accepts and acknowledges that there are risks associated with participation in Wee Wanderers, or other Club activities, and agrees, on behalf of both themselves and the Child, to assume the full risk of any and all injuries and/or loss that the Child may sustain as a result of participation Wee Wanderer’s or other Club activities, or from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained, or controlled by the Club or resulting from both the Child’s actions and the actions of others.
3. The Parent acknowledges that the Club provides the Wee Wanderers program in connection with other Club activities and agrees to release and indemnify the Club, its officers, employees and volunteers from and against any claims and/or liability that arises as a result the Club’s acts, omissions, negligence or recklessness in relation to the Child’s participation in any activities and/or enrolment with the Club.
4. The Parent agrees to indemnify the Club, its past and present employees, volunteers and agents from any and all third-party claims caused in whole or in part by the Child’s negligent and/or intentional acts or omissions.
5. The Parent accepts and acknowledges that this activity or event may test a person’s physical limits and may carry with it the potential for death or serious injury. The risks may include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of participants, equipment, actions of other people including but not limited to participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches, event officials, and event monitors, and/or producers of the event, and lack of hydration. These risks are not only inherent to participants, but are also present for volunteers. Any such injury may result not only from the Child’s actions, including physical exertion, but also from the action, omission or negligence of others.



6. The Parent, on behalf of the Child, agrees that the Child will comply with all rules and warnings made available by the Club and its employees, volunteers and agents in respect to the activities and will follow any instructions or directions given by any employees, representatives or agents of the Club.
7. The Parent acknowledges that the Club is committed to conducting the Wee Wanderers program in a safe manner, holds the safety of participants in the highest regard and attempts to reduce risk by insisting that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect participants' safety.
8. The Parent warrants that the Child is physically fit and has no medical condition that would make participation in the Wee Wanderer's more dangerous, risky or hazardous. The Parent further warrants that in the event that the Child suffers, or recently suffered, a physical or mental impairment, illness or injury, the Parent and Child have consulted their treating physician before participating in Wee Wanderers, or other club activities.
9. The Client acknowledges that they are solely responsible for determining if the Child is physically fit and/or sufficiently skilled to participate in Wee Wanderers, or other Club activities.
10. The Client warrants that the Child is not currently taking any medications or substances that will inhibit the Child's mental and/or physical ability to safely and effectively participate in Wee Wanderers, or other club activities, unless otherwise disclosed in writing to the Club, prior to participation.
11. In the event of injury or illness to the Child, the Parent consents to medical care and transportation being obtained by and at the discretion of the Club, its employees, volunteers or agents for the entire period that the Child is present at Wee Wanderer's and/or participates in the any club activities. The Parent acknowledges that they will be notified as soon as reasonably possible if the Child becomes ill or injured while under the supervision of the Club.
12. The Parent agrees that the details of any special medical treatment and/or restrictions concerning the Child's health and medical treatment will be provided to the Club in writing prior to the Child's participation in Wee Wanderers, or other club activities.
13. The Parent acknowledges that this disclaimer extends to any liability arising out of or in any way connected with any medical treatment and transportation provided to the Child while under the supervision of the Club.
14. The Parent agrees that the Club is not responsible for any personal items or property that may be lost, damaged or stolen as a result of the Child's participation in Wee Wanderers, or other club activities.

15. The Parent gives the Club and any of its employees and/or subcontractors permission to photograph the Child. The Client acknowledges that any photograph remains the property of the Club and may be used for promotional or any other purposes.

16. As a Level 3 Accredited Good Sports Club, it is the policy of Wanderers RFC to promote & manage the responsible service of alcohol. This policy applies to all Club facilities, functions, meetings and activities. It is also relevant to all Club officials, members, players, volunteers, visitors and guests.

17. The Parent acknowledges that they have read and fully understood this disclaimer and they agree on both their behalf and the behalf of the Child, to be bound by the contents of this disclaimer.
